Who purchases electricity in Jamaica?

JPS purchases approximately 297 MW of electricity from Independent Power Producers (IPPs) such as Jamaica Energy Partners (JEP), Jamaica Private Power Company (JPPC), Jamalco, and Wigton Wind Farm.

Who owns Jamaica Private Power Co Ltd?

As of October 30, 2007, Inkia Energy Limited owned Jamaica Private Power Co. Ltd. JPPC operates two 29.8 MW slow speed diesel generation units, two heat recovery steam generators, and a 4.2 MW steam turbine generator at a plant located in Kingston, Jamaica. The plant, which is a subsidiary of Inkia Energy Limited, achieved Commercial Operations on January 6, 1998.
