

What if Mauritius has sovereignty over the British Indian Ocean territory?

Under the terms of the Agreement, the United Kingdom will agree that the Republic of Mauritius has sovereignty over the British Indian Ocean Territory, also known as the Chagos Archipelago. In return, Mauritius will authorise us to exercise their sovereign rights needed for the long-term, secure, and effective operation of the joint military base.

When was the British Indian Ocean Territory created?

The British Indian Ocean Territory was created by separating parts of Mauritius and the Seychelles, prior to their ascendency to independence from British rule in 1968and 1976 respectively. Britain agreed at the time to return the islands when no longer required for defense purposes.

Why is the British Indian Ocean territory important?

Since the British Indian Ocean Territory's creation, Britain has used the islands to maintain close ties with the United States. For instance, U.S. access to Diego Garcia was deployed as a bargaining chip three times during the Cold War to further Britain's nuclear weapons capabilities.

Does the British Indian Ocean territory have a military base on Diego Garcia?

However, since its creation, the British Indian Ocean Territory and the joint UK-US military baseon Diego Garcia has had a contested existence. It has been challenged through various international courts and tribunals, threatening the long-term, secure operation of the base. In recent years, this threat had risen significantly.

Can You Moor a boat in the Indian Ocean?

Yacht crews seeking safe passage across the Indian Ocean may apply for a mooring permitfor the uninhabited Outer Islands (beyond Diego Garcia), but must not approach within 3 nautical miles (5.6 kilometres; 3.5 miles), land on, or anchor at islands designated as Strict Nature Reserves, or the nature reserve within the Peros Banhos atoll.
