They lived in isolation and ...

The Oeno Island is located some 128 km northwest of Pitcairn Island. It is a small coral atoll which is often used as a private holiday site by the population of Pitcairn Island with palm trees, lovely beaches, and a sheltered lagoon. Further east, you'll find Ducie Island which is a circular reef and island. This island is rarely visited ...

Discovery of Pitcairn Island . Captain Philip Carteret first spotted Pitcairn Island in 1767 but couldn't land due to rough seas. He miscalculated its location, marking it miles away from its true position. Years later, Captain Cook showed some interest, but it wasn't until the Bounty mutineers arrived in 1790 that the island gained attention.
