

What is a digital nomad visa in South Africa?

Announced in May 2024, the South African digital nomad visa allows foreign nationals to live in South Africa and work for a foreign company or as a freelancer with overseas clients. The digital nomad visa allows applicants to live and work in South Africa for a maximum of three years, with renewal options available.

Are digital nomads taxed in South Africa?

Digital nomads granted a six-month visa will not be taxed in South Africa. However, digital nomads staying longer than six months in a 36-month period must register with the South African Revenue Service (SARS) and pay local income tax. It is still unclear exactly how long the initial visa term will be and if there will be limited renewals.
