

What is the British Indian Ocean territory?

The British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT), is an overseas territory of the United Kingdomsituated in the Indian Ocean halfway between Tanzania and Indonesia, and directly south of the Maldives.

Does the British Indian Ocean territory have a 'secrecy'?

The infamous Ordinance to which Aust referred, banned all persons from the islands. However, the same 'secrecy' applies to all of the legislation of the British Indian Ocean Territory, both then and now. It is not widely publicised. A copy of each BIOT Gazette is required to be deposited in the British Library for public access.

What are the laws of the British Indian Ocean territory?

The laws of the BIOT derive their authority under the Royal Prerogative. Through the 'British Indian Ocean Territory Order 1965' (an Order in Council), the Queen vested duties and powers on the Commissioner to make 'laws for the peace, order and good government of the Territory".

The British Indian Ocean Territory is located in the Indian Ocean at 3,650 kilometers from the coast of eastern Africa. The British Indian Ocean Territory was formed as a British colony in 1965 from the Aldabra Atoll, the Farquhar Atoll and Desroches Island, formerly part of the Seychelles and the Chagos Archipelago which was formerly part of Mauritius.

The Archipelago was made a colony, the British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT). It subsequently became a British Overseas Territory.
