How many solar power projects are there in Zimbabwe?

As of 31 July 2019,the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) had issued more than 77 power generation licences with 42being solar power projects. A number of IPPs are already selling electricity to the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC) and feeding into the national grid.

Will Kariba Dam get a 250-megawatt solar power plant?

The Intensive Energy User Group,made up of mining companies including a former local unit of Rio Tinto and Mimosa,plan a 250-megawatt plant at the Kariba Dam to be implemented in 18 months,according to a copy of its presentation seen by Bloomberg. That can be expanded to 1 gigawatt of solar capacity.
